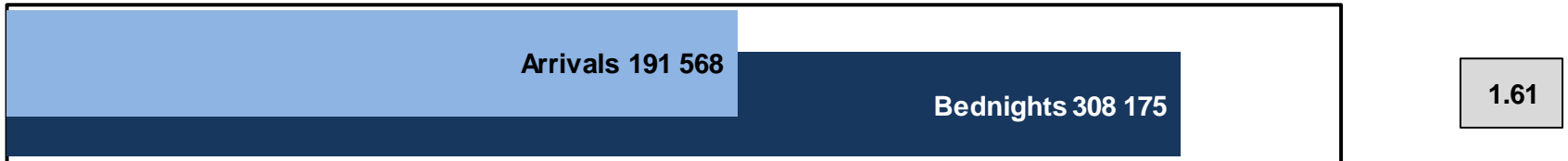

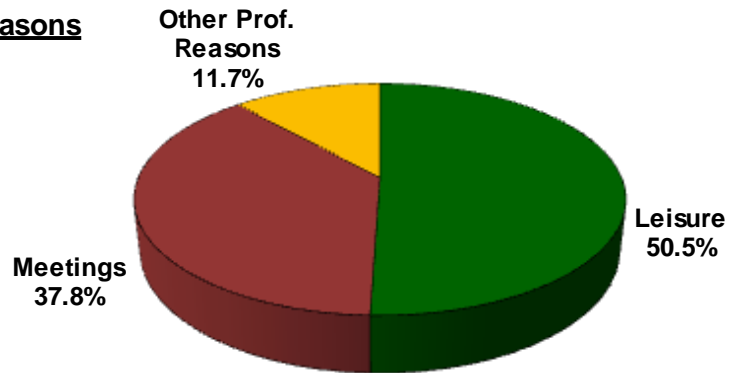

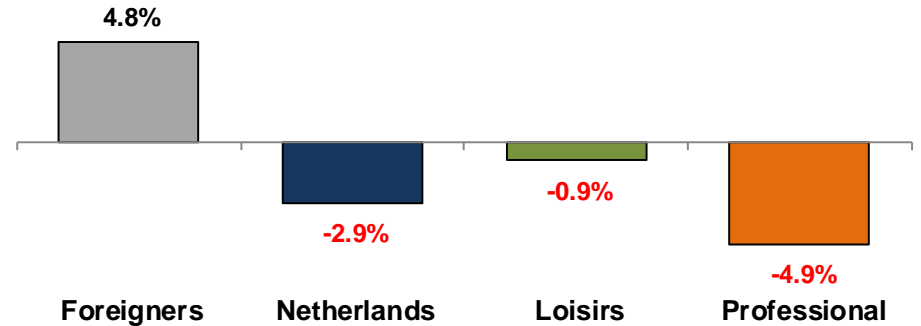

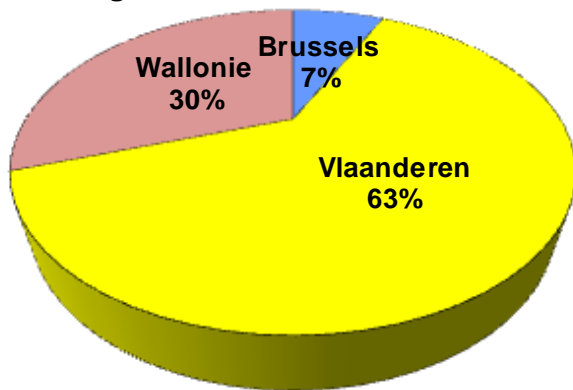

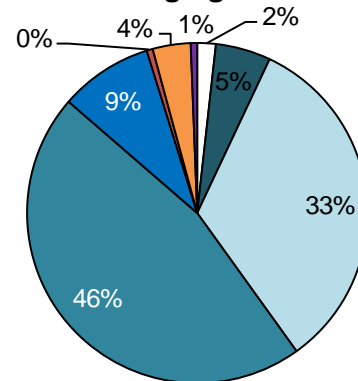
### Bednights evolution vs. year before



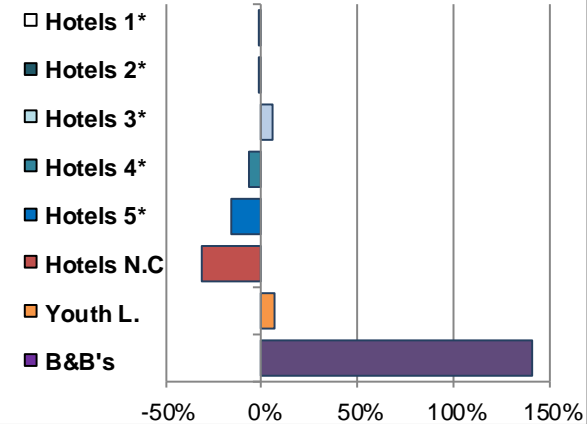

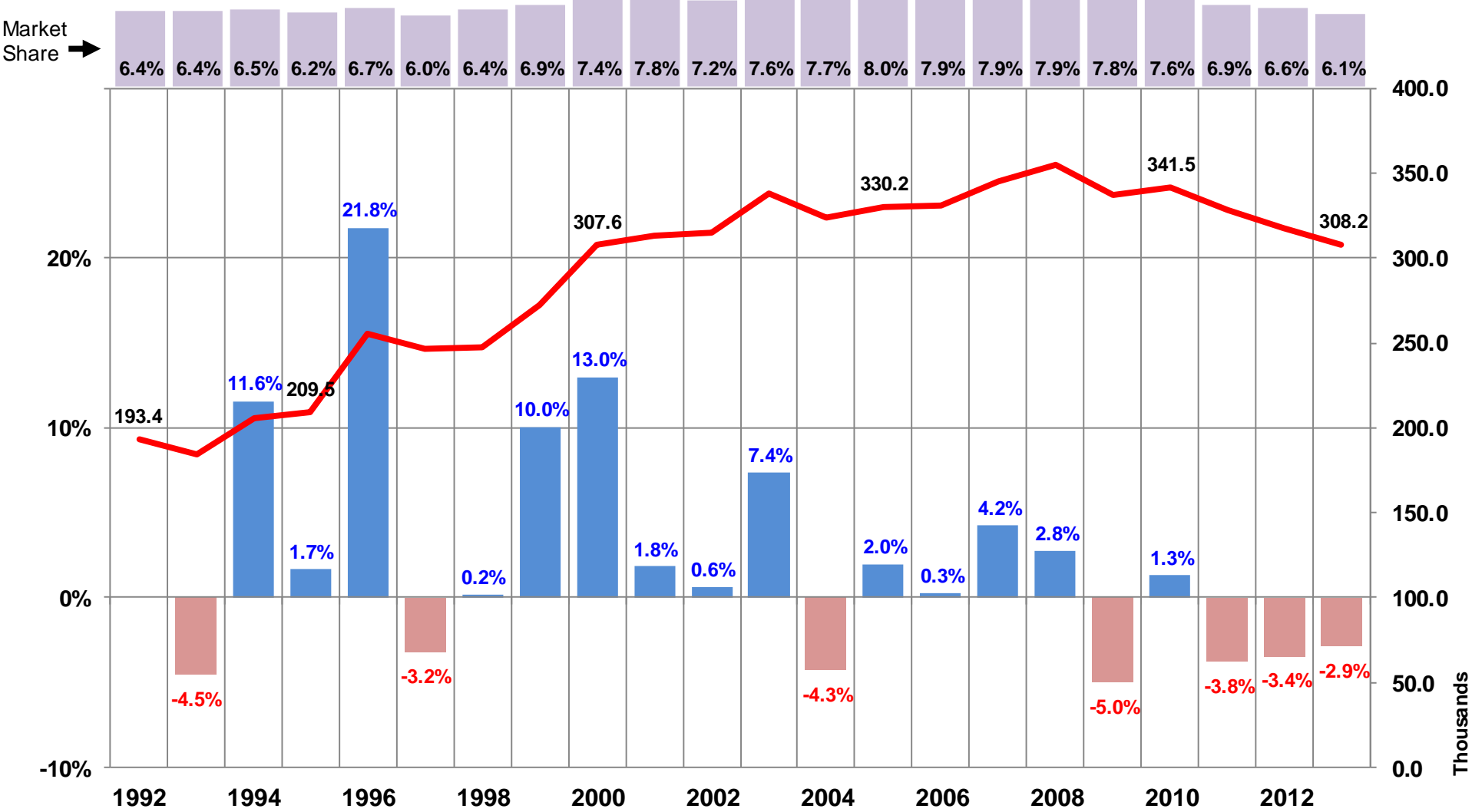

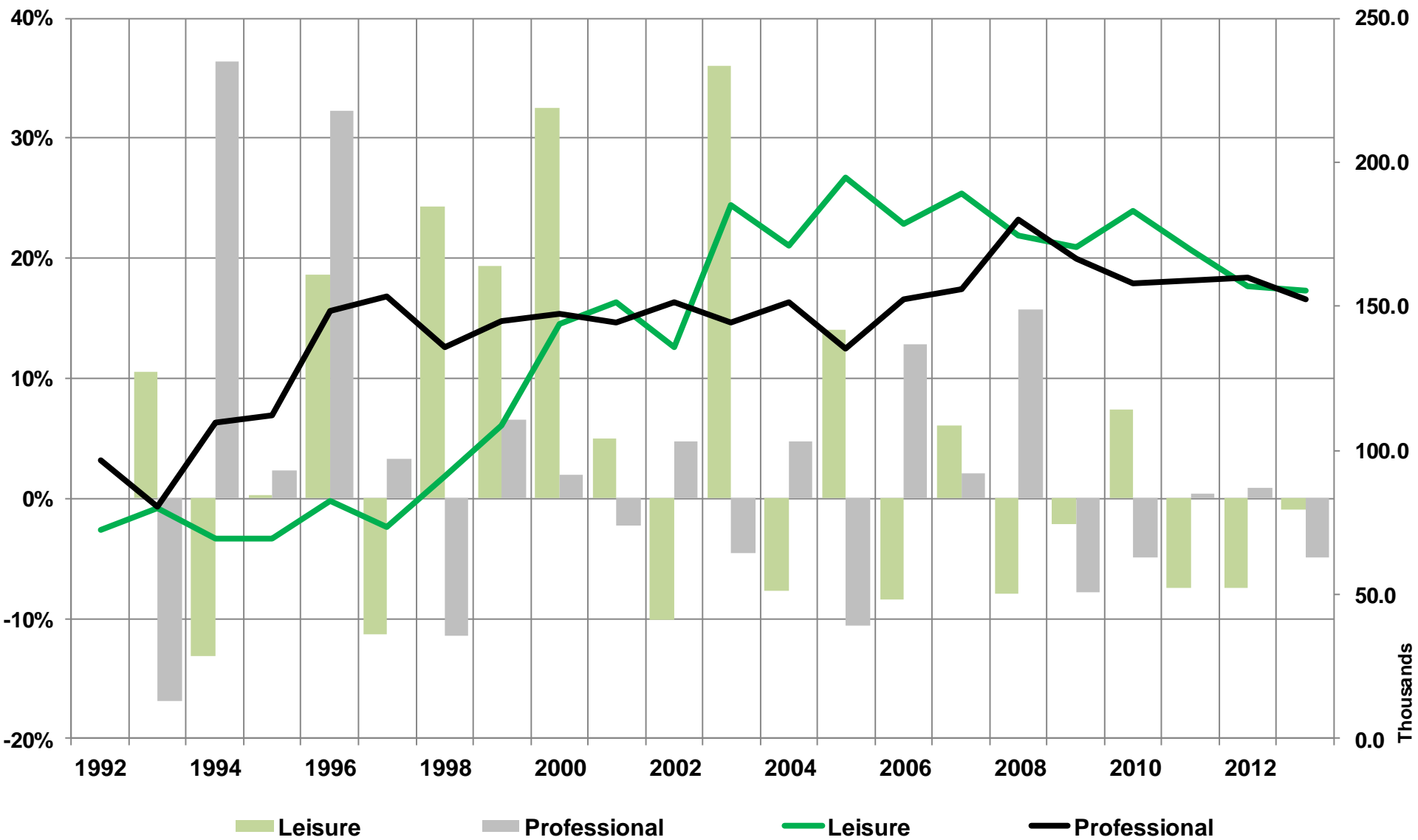

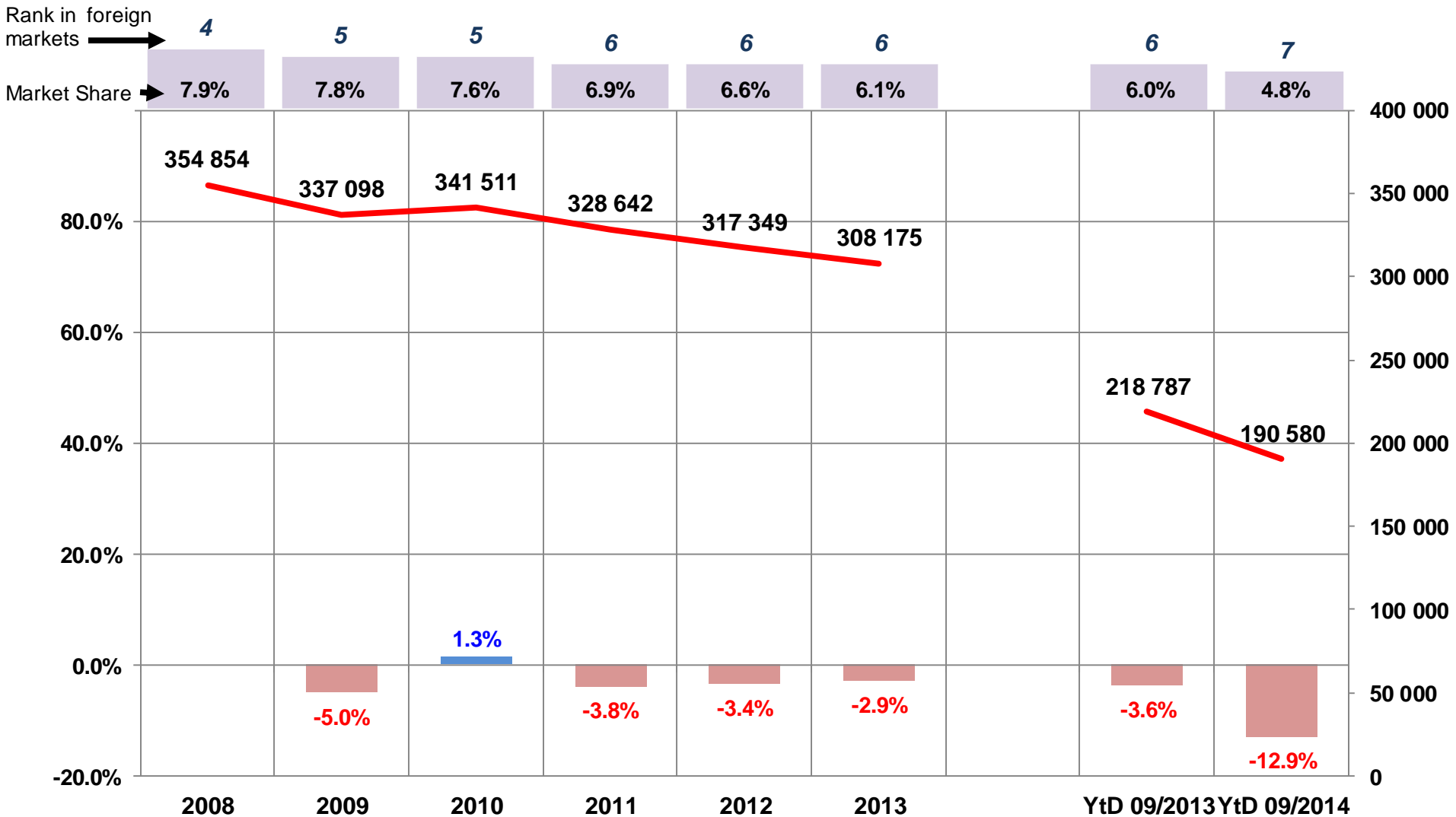
## Long Term - Bednights by year & evolution YoY Market share in foreign markets



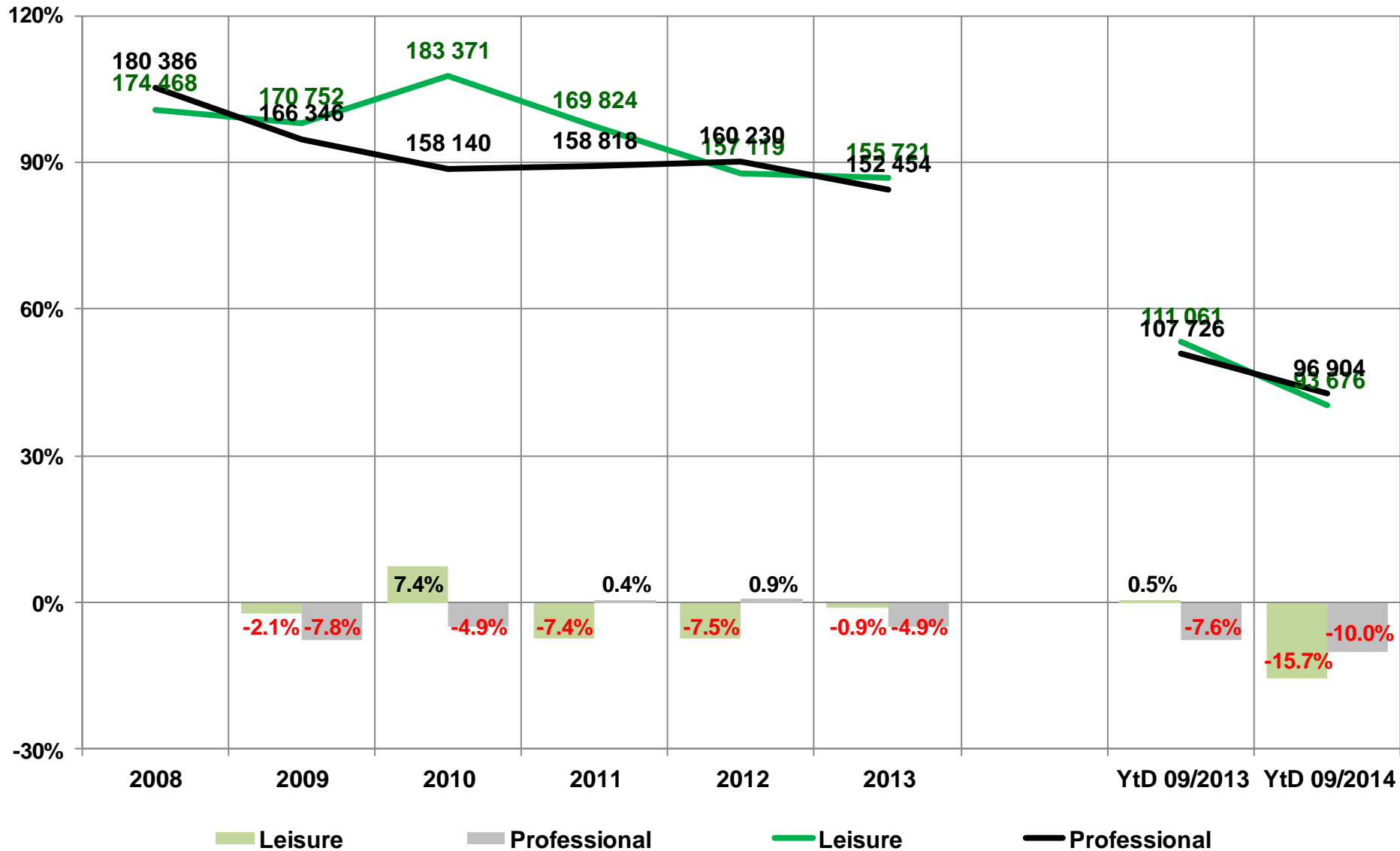

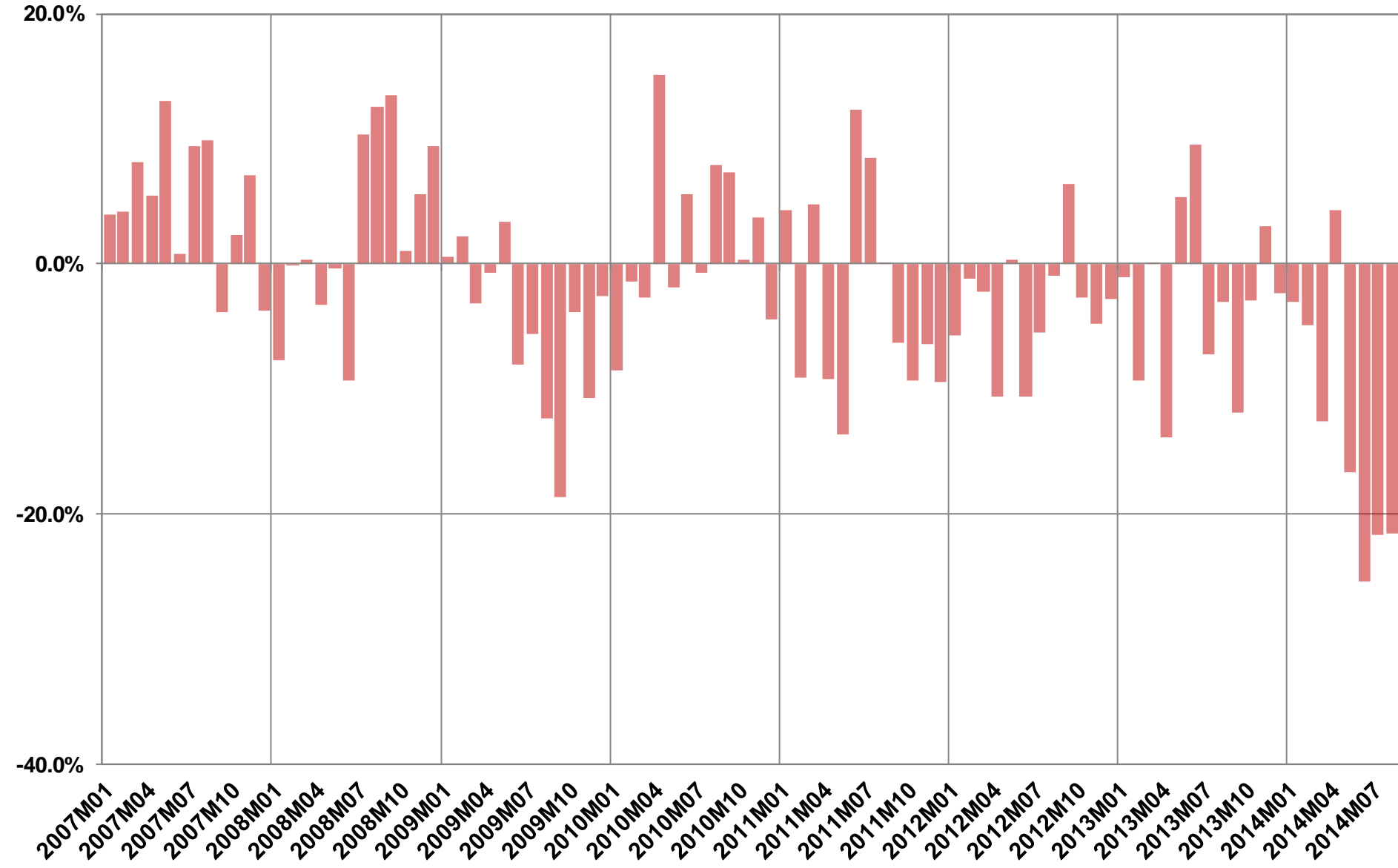

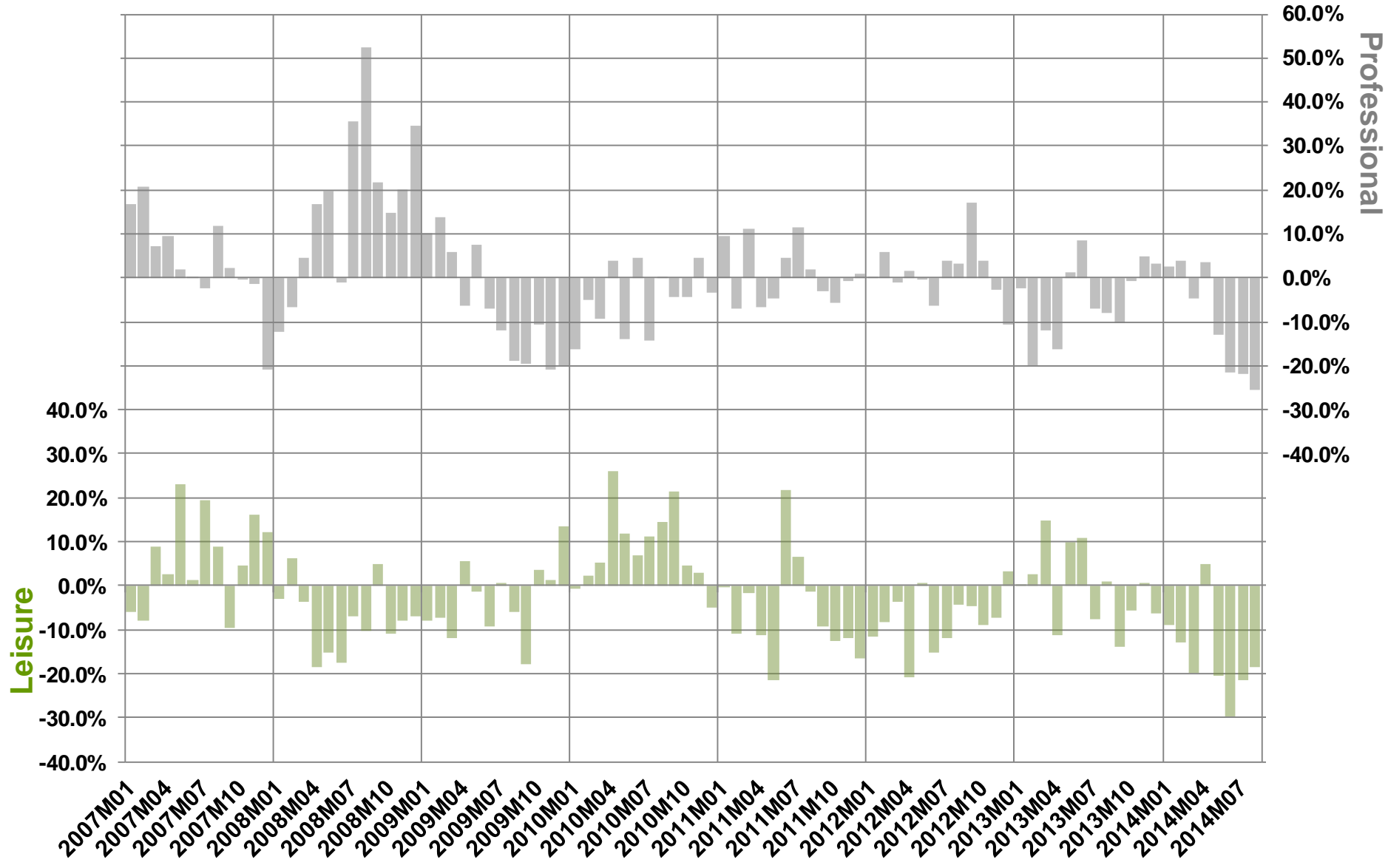

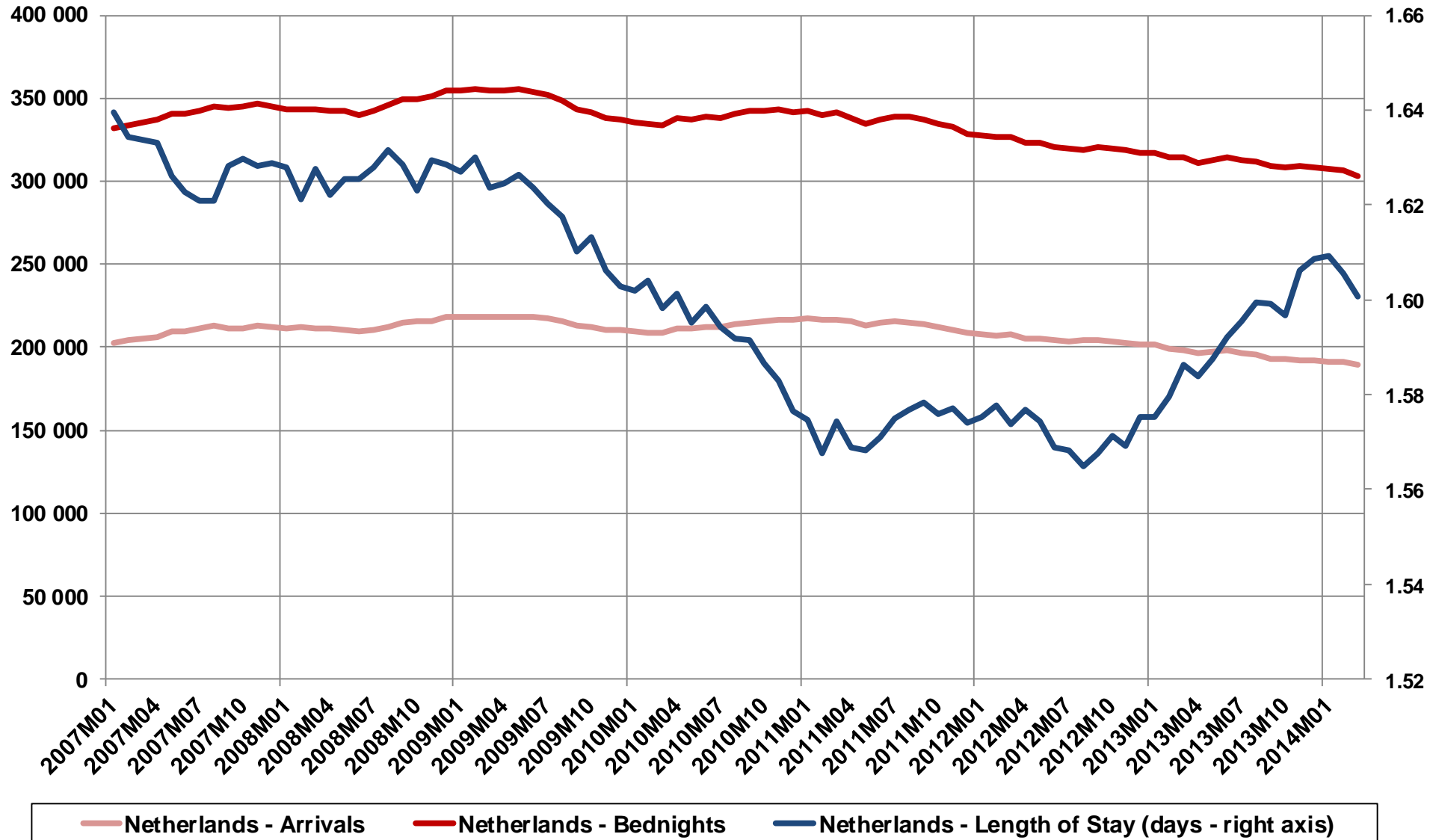

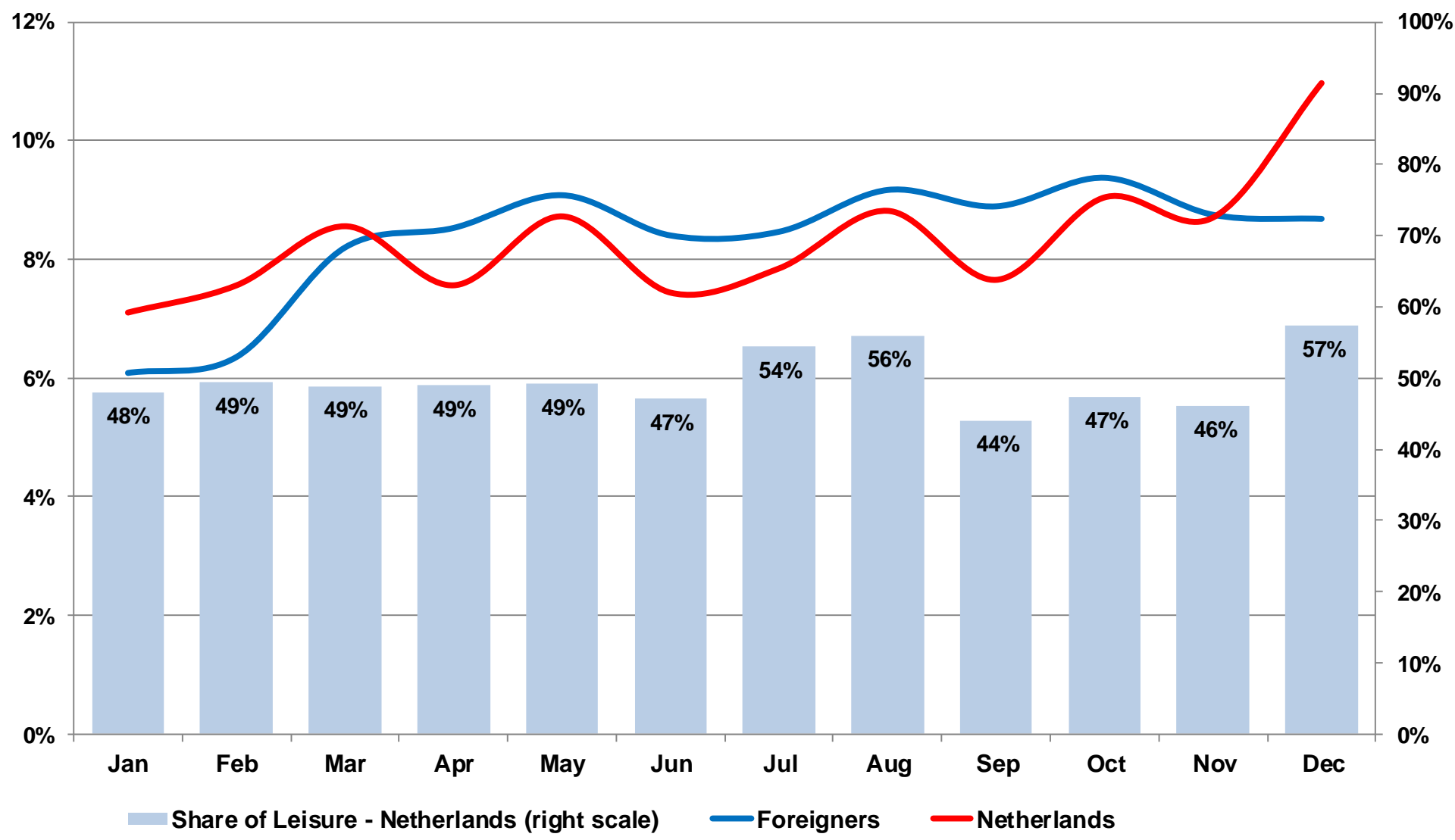




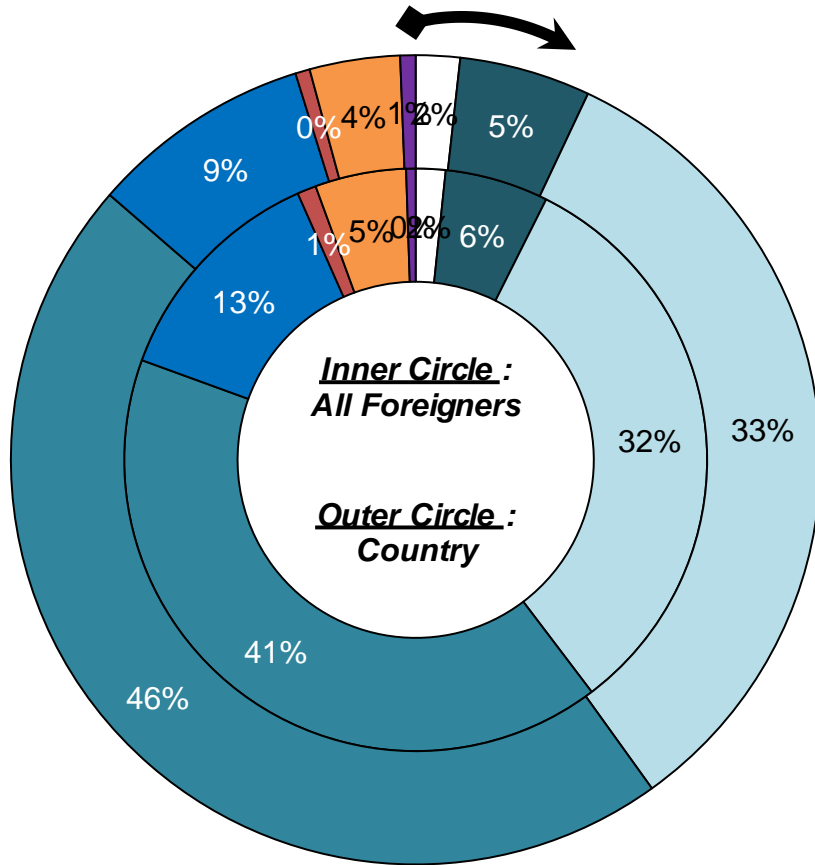
## Arrivals/Bednights and Length of Stay - Moving Annual Totals



## Percentage of Bednights per month & Share of Leisure Average 2012-2013

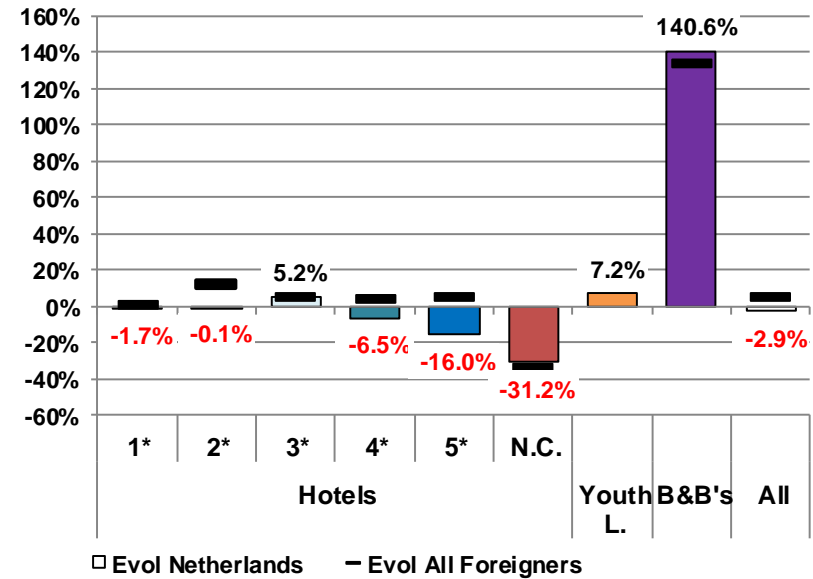
